"Indispensable Partnership: Japan and India Amidst Shifting Global Dynamics"

Tokyo, November 15-16, 2023

Event Profile

The Japan Institute of International Affairs (JIIA) and the Delhi Policy Group (DPG) are set to convene the 6th annual Japan-India Indo-Pacific Forum (9th India-Japan Track 1.5 Dialogue) in Tokyo on November 15-16, 2023. The objective of this Track 1.5 dialogue is to foster a deeper intellectual exchange, enhance understanding of each other's perspectives regarding the rapidly evolving regional and global order, and advance their mutual interests in the Indo-Pacific region.

Since the previous dialogue held in New Delhi on November 23, 2022, the global landscape has experienced substantial deterioration, with the world order facing significant distress. In both Asia and Europe, there is a stark exhibition of unrestrained power for expansionist and coercive endeavors. The conflict in Ukraine persist despite calls for peaceful resolution and tensions surrounding Taiwan and the Philippines continue to escalate to unprecedented levels. Moreover, the "Israel-Hamas war" adds another layer of complexity to the geopolitical landscape. Upholding a global order based on the UN Charter, international law, and respect for the sovereignty and territorial integrity of all states is deemed imperative at this critical juncture. Considering the aforementioned circumstances, it is essential to reflect upon the significance and responsibilities of Japan as the host of the G7, and India as the host of the G20.

The 6th Indo-Pacific Forum aims to deepen the understanding of Japan and India's shared interests and actions towards Indo-Pacific stability, security, and prosperity amidst a changing global order. The first closed session explores global power shifts, QUAD's cooperation with regional bodies, addressing challenges from China, and discussing reformed multilateralism and the G20's role in a global order. The second closed session delves into India-Japan bilateral relations, focusing on maritime security, defense equipment cooperation, and economic security, including collaboration on critical technologies. The concluding Live/Public session of the Forum disseminates the collaborative resolve of India and Japan in shaping the Indo-Pacific's future, covering their economic, technological, defense, and security ties, and coordinated approach on Indo-Pacific issues and global challenges.
