#### **Abstract**

Amidst US withdrawal from Afghanistan, China is looking to increase its influence in the Middle East. Chinese President Xi Jinping spoke with Iranian President Ebrahim Raisi and Iraqi PM Barham Salih. He reiterated Beijing's support for Tehran's "legitimate demands" in nuclear negotiations [Vienna talks], while expressing confidence that "no matter how the international and regional situation changes, China will unswervingly develop friendly relations with Iran". With regards to Iraq, President Xi stressed that "China will support country's reconstruction efforts". Even as China's engagement in the region increases, analysts are concerned at Taliban's haul of US weapons and equipment left behind in Afghanistan that has the potential to including China's destabilize the region Xinjiang Uvghur Autonomous region.

Continuing India's deepening of strategic partnership with Israel, Prime Minister Modi spoke with his Israeli counterpart Naftali Bennett on August 16. "They reviewed all areas of India-Israel cooperation and agreed on the tremendous potential of bilateral strategic partnership, especially in technology and innovation". India's defence partnership with the Gulf countries has strengthened considerably over the past few years. As a result, India and Qatar held second edition of joint naval exercise, 'Zair-Al-Bahr', while India and Bahrain held Passage Exercise (PASSEX) in the Gulf.

Qatar is emerging as the first point of contact for nations who want to engage the Taliban [Islamic Emirate of Afghanistan]. In light of this, India's External Affairs Minister Dr. S. Jaishankar met Qatar's Foreign Minister in Doha to "exchange views on Afghanistan".

As regards trade and economy, Indian company 'DCM Shriram' is investing USD 1 million in Turkish drone maker 'Zyrone Dynamics'. DCM Shriram stressed that "the partnership is more than just an



investment; it is about creating a global UAV company for various applications in civilian and military fields". Zyrone Dynamics spoke about this partnership "creating products for civilian use, especially for cargo transportation". In another development, India's SVP Group owned subsidiary SV Pittie Sohar Textiles has commenced commercial operations at its mega textile plant with investment of USD 150 million in Oman's 'Sohar Free Trade Zone'.

In a development impacting Indian migrant workers, Indian Ambassador to Kuwait met director of Kuwait's Public Authority for Manpower and expressed New Delhi's interest in providing more domestic workers to the gulf country. Meanwhile, Indian Ambassador to Egypt highlighted an upward trajectory in bilateral trade.

In a boost for Indian tourists, UAE and Kuwait have allowed Indian passport holders to enter the country on a tourist visa provided that they haven't visited or been in India in the last 14 days.

On the energy front, as noted in the earlier issue of West Asia Review, India had overhauled its strategic petroleum reserves policy to boost private investment. As a result, India has begun selling oil from its strategic petroleum reserves to state-run refiners.

Japanese Foreign Minister Motegi visited Tehran and met Iran's President and Foreign Minister. Tehran informed Tokyo that "Iran is not against negotiations" but the "Americans must answer to the world's public opinion [as to] why they did not implement their commitments under the JCPOA and exited this international accord". Iran has also called on Japan to release its funds frozen in the country because of the US sanctions.

On the US-Iran relations, Washington and its European allies called on Iran to "halt nuclear escalations" as the International Atomic Energy Agency [IAEA] claimed that "Iran has made progress in its work on enriched uranium metal". US Department of State asserted that "Iran



has no credible need to produce uranium metal, which has direct relevance to nuclear weapons development". Meanwhile, Iranian Defence Ministry declared that Tehran will "continue its missile program and expand its defence efforts beyond the borders of the country". This could be seen as a message of deterrence to the US, Israel, and the West. In another development, reportedly US shot down Iranian drone in Eastern Syria. The US also showed concerns about Iran sending more sophisticated weapons to Yemen's Houthi rebels amid ceasefire efforts by Riyadh and Washington.

Amid growing regional tensions, President Biden will host new Israeli Prime Minister Naftali Bennett at 'The White House' on August 26. The two leaders will discuss "critical issues related to regional and global security, including Iran".

Former Afghan President Ashraf Ghani who fled the country on August 15 landed in UAE to seek refuge as the Taliban declared Islamic Emirate in Afghanistan. US withdrawal from Afghanistan risks emboldening radical Islamic terrorist organizations worldwide. Al-Qaeda, Hamas, and Hezbollah are gloating over Taliban's victory and "downfall of America". Reportedly, even the Gulf Arab Nations are jittery about Taliban's rule in Afghanistan, but may seek pragmatic relations in future. Saudi Arabia and UAE had recognized Taliban's rule in Afghanistan from 1996-2001. It remains to be seen if they could exert religious and economic clout to moderate Taliban.

Now Zyrone will sell its products to India and its neighbours in the Asian market, after which it also hopes to export drones to Europe and Australia."

The Taliban's takeover of Afghanistan following two decades of US occupation risks emboldening jihadists worldwide as al-Qaeda-connected groups in Syria and Yemen have already welcomed the Taliban's victory, in a sign they could be emboldened to ratchet up their activities in the period to come.

<u>Iran Sending More Weapons to Yemen's Houthis amid Cease-fire Effort: Pentagon</u>

Foreign Ministry spokesman Saeed Khatibzadeh dismissed the recent remarks by a member of Yemeni President Abd-Rabbu Mansour Hadi's government as "false" concerning the killing of an Iranian citizen in Yemen's conflicts.
