## Abstract

In a major development with far-reaching impact on regional security, Israel successfully tested the "Iron Beam" Laser Interception System. Israeli Prime Minister, Naftali Bennett, declared that "Iron Beam is the world's first energybased weapons system that uses a laser to shoot down incoming UAVs, rockets, and mortars at a cost of USD 3.50 per shot". Importantly, 'Iron Beam' will be used alongside the 'Iron Dome' as part of Israel's multi-tier air defence.

Amidst the ongoing Russia-Ukraine conflict and its serious impact on food security, Egypt has approved India as a wheat supplier. Reportedly, Cairo is looking to import one million tonnes of wheat from India, while Lebanon is finalizing the import of 50,000 tonnes of wheat.

Continuing the inflow of Gulf investments into India, Blackrock together with UAE's Mubadala will invest USD 525 million in Tata Powers Renewable Energy arm. On the other hand, Abu Dhabi Investment Authority (ADIA), Qatar Investment Authority (QIA), Singapore's GIC, and three Canadian pension funds have shown interest in becoming anchor investors in Life Insurance Corporation of India's (LIC) Initial Public Offering (IPO). In another development, even as the Vienna talks on Iran nuclear deal remain stalled and its outcome uncertain, India and Iran are likely to soon begin talks to explore opportunities to resume direct bilateral trade in crude oil and fertilizers.

Amidst strained US-Saudi Arabia relations, the Israeli Ambassador in Washington called on the two countries to "fix" their relations as they are "very important to the Middle East" security and stability. Meanwhile, Saudi Crown Prince, Mohammed bin Salman, spoke with Russian President Vladimir Putin to discuss issues such as joint work under the OPEC+ format, and the situation in Ukraine, and Yemen. Saudi Crown Prince also held a telephonic conversation with Chinese President Xi Jinping with a view to further deepening the comprehensive bilateral strategic partnership.

Amidst heightened tensions in Israel, the al-Agsa mosque in Jerusalem was raided by Israeli police injuring over 150 Palestinians. Iran, as well as Saudi Arabia, condemned Israeli actions. Riyadh termed it as a "systematic escalation and a blatant attack on the sacredness of al-Agsa and its place in the heart of the Islamic nation". While Tehran called on the "Muslims to stand united behind the Palestinian cause while reminding Gulf leaders that normalisation of relations



with the apartheid regime only encourages Israel to double down on its brutality". The United States, on its part, urged both "Israelis and Palestinians to exercise restraint, avoid provocative actions and rhetoric, and preserve the historic status quo on the Haram al-Sharif/Temple Mount".
