Abstract

Prime Minister, Narendra Modi, expressed condolences on the passing away of UAE's President, 'Sheikh Khalifa Bin Zayed Al Nahyan'. Indian Vice President, M Venkaiah Naidu, met the new President of UAE, 'Sheikh Mohamed bin Zayed' to offer condolences on behalf of the nation and paid rich tributes to Late Sheikh Khalifa's contribution in boosting India-UAE relations. Prime Minister, Narendra Modi, expressed confidence that "under Sheikh Mohamed's dynamic and visionary leadership, India-UAE Comprehensive Economic Partnership Agreement will continue to deepen". Meanwhile, India and UAE launched 'Startup Bridge' to provide a platform to entrepreneurs from both sides to further deepen the trade partnership. Further, India is mulling a preferential trade agreement (PTA) with Oman.

Even as India decided to ban the export of wheat, Egypt claimed that "Cairo was in talks with New Delhi for an exemption from this ban". Reportedly, Egypt will buy 500,000 tonnes of wheat from India to meet its food security needs. India is also sending wheat consignments to Oman as West Asia-North Africa continues to face major wheat supply disruptions owing to the conflict in Ukraine.

Amidst the change of government in Pakistan, Imran Khan-led Pakistan Tehreeki-Insaf (PTI) slammed the federal government for its "intentions to resume trade with India without resolving the Kashmir dispute, as also accord recognition to Israel".

With regards to talks on Iran nuclear deal, in the aftermath of Enrique Mora's visit to Tehran, European Union's Foreign Policy Chief, Josep Borrell, asserted that "the discussions between EU and Iran were better than expected" and "the stalled negotiations have now been reopened". However, Iranian National Security Advisor, Ali Shamkhani, continued to maintain that the "US must accept Iranian" demands [a possible reference to the removal of IRGC from US Foreign Terrorist Organization list] to break nuclear talks deadlock". Washington still remains uncertain about the prospects of reviving the nuclear deal. Meanwhile, Qatar's Emir, Sheikh Tamim bin Hamad Al Thani met Iranian Supreme Leader, Ayatollah Ali Khamenei and President Ebrahim Raisi in Tehran. The two leaders discussed bilateral and regional issues including efforts to revive the 2015 Joint Comprehensive Plan of Action (JCPoA). While commenting on Israel, the Iranian Supreme Leader warned Sheikh Tamim that "relations with Israel do not promise any power or privilege and one should not be scared by their position".



Amidst rising energy prices and inflation, US Senate Committee passed 'No Oil Producing and Exporting Cartels' (NOPEC) bill that, if signed into law by the President – will pave way for lawsuits against OPEC for anti-trust behaviour and market manipulation. Criticizing this, UAE and Saudi Arabia's Energy Minister's warned Washington that "OPEC was being unfairly targeted for the energy crisis and the NOPEC bill would disrupt established system of crude production and could see oil prices shoot up by as much as 300 percent". As the crude prices continue to hover around USD 110/barrel, Saudi Aramco's first-quarter profits surged by 80 percent allowing it to overtake 'Apple' as the world's most valuable company.

Turkey - a NATO member, mediating between Russia and Ukraine, is "not favourable" toward the proposed expansion of NATO to induct Finland and Sweden. There are reports that it could veto the move. The United States and NATO, however, have expressed confidence that they will address Ankara's concerns so that Turkey will not oppose Finland and Sweden's admission. On its part, the Kremlin warned Finland that joining NATO would impact bilateral relations and that "ending the traditional policy of military neutrality would be a mistake as there is no threat to Finland's security".
