Abstract

External Affairs Minister Dr. S. Jaishankar will inaugurate 'India Global Forum' in UAE on December 12. This five-day forum brings together political, business, and cultural personalities from the two countries to discuss India's global aspirations and priorities during its G-20 Presidency.

India's Department of Commerce has sought details from the Agriculture Ministry and Embassy in Tehran as to why Iran has stopped importing rice and tea from India. In another development, G7 "Price Cap" and ambiguity in the insurance rates for tankers carrying Russian crude have slowed down their movement, particularly off the coast of Turkey. This is unlikely to impact the movement of Russian crude to India. Meanwhile, Russia has offered to collaborate with India on leasing and building large-capacity ships.

Chinese President Xi Jinping attended 'China-Arab States Summit' and 'China-Gulf Cooperation Council (GCC) Summit in Riyadh, on December 9. Xinhua commentary asserted that the two summits have taken China-Arab and China-GCC relations to "new heights" by "strengthening mutually beneficial cooperation", "promoting common security and development", and "advancing dialogue among civilisations".

China and Saudi Arabia are aligned on several major policy issues, including the digital economy, space research, infrastructure, Iran's nuclear program, Yemen war, and the Ukraine conflict. To further internationalise the Chinese Yuan, President Xi Jinping emphasised the use of the Yuan in importing oil and gas from the Gulf. Non-interference in domestic affairs remains a shared principle between China and Saudi Arabia.

Concerned with these developments, John Kirby - White House National Security Council spokesman warned that China's attempts at spreading its influence around the world was "not conducive to preserving the international rules-based order". Reiterating that "the U.S. is not asking nations to choose between the U.S. and China", John Kirby reminded that "Washington was well poised to lead the strategic competition with Beijing". On its part, Saudi Arabia maintained that it remains "open to everyone" and will not abandon cooperation with the U.S. in pursuit of relations with China.
